

## Bayside Swimming Club Travel Code of Conduct

As a member of the Bayside Swimming Club, I promise that I will follow the Rules and Code of Conduct as outlined below to represent the Bayside Swimming Club and the Victorian/Australian Swimming communities.

I will adhere to the following conduct and behavioral policies:

1. Interact with others displaying caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility.
2. Respect of yourself shown through your dress and behavior.
3. Respect of your peers shown through your interaction and consideration for others.
4. Respect of your Coaches shown through your interaction and attentiveness.
5. Respect of Bayside parents that may help remind you of rules and conduct you agreed to follow.
6. Do not participate in creating or sustaining rumors or negativity.
7. Do not participate in illegal activities (i.e. stealing, assault, use/possession/distribution of illegal drugs and/or alcohol).
8. Do not participate in any acts of hazing or physical or mental abuse towards past, current, or future team mates for any reason.
9. Do not pursue any unwanted physical contact.
10. Bayside Swimming Club does not support team fraternization.
11. Do not participate in any unsafe activities that may cause harm to yourself or others.
12. Do not participate in activities that can be detrimental to the image or reputation of the Bayside Swimming Club, Victorian or Australian swimming.
13. Participate in all team-based activities with positivity and good humor.
14. Be prepared to be at your best mentally, physically and emotionally for every training session.
15. Use common sense when making decisions; when in doubt, do not do it.
16. All athletes must be in their own rooms unless otherwise specified. Any variations to the schedule must be explicitly approved by the coaches.
17. Under **NO** circumstances are female or male athletes allowed to be in the same room without coach supervision.
18. This is an important training trip not a dating safari, treat it as such.

If you violate any of the above, you will be subject to consequences that will be dealt with on an individual basis left to the discretion of the Head Coach, Swimming Victoria/Australia and Local Authorities. For serious violations, the athlete(s) will be sent home at the expense of the parents.
