AUSTRALIA DAY OPEN WATER SWIM – 26TH JANUARY 2015

Bayside Swimming Club had a team of swimmers attend the Great Australia Day Swim on Monday 26th January. There were 3 different types of events that the swimmers competed in. The more challenging swim was the 5km distance which was a course around a marked circuit, finish around the breakwater to the beach. Then there was the 1400m swim which was a clockwise course around the Middle Brighton Pier and breakwater from the pier to the Finish gate on the beach. The 650m swim a shorter course from the Northern end of the Royal Brighton Yacht Club marina to the beach.

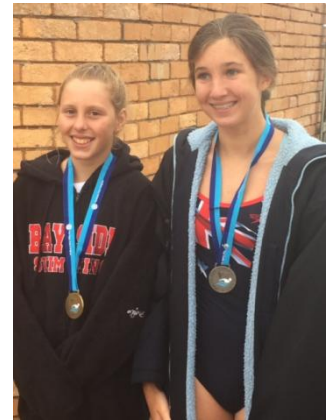
Max Putamorsi swam in the 12-17yrs age group and competed in both the 5km and the 1400m. Max came 1st in the 5km swim in a time of 1:19:59 and 2nd in the 1400m in a time of 18:58. Also competing in the 1400m event were Liam McLeod who took 5th place in a time of 19:19, Costas Papadopoulos coming in 11th in a time of 21:24 and Joshua Cooley coming in 12th in a time of 22:18.





Jade Boyd competed in the Junior Dash 300m and came 1st in the 11yrs old category and Jordan Anderson came 1st in the 12yr old category. Audrey Fogarty and Georgie Gore competed in the female section in the 12-17yrs category in the 1400m event. Audrey came in 4th with a time of 21:45 and Georgie coming 7th in a time of 22:24.

Ben Putamorsi competed in the 650metres and obtained a 1st, in the U16 age group in a time of 6:03.
