2015 PACIFIC SCHOOL GAMES



Congratulations to all swimmers who swam at the Pacific School Games that were held from the 20-27th November. Bayside had a few swimmers who qualified for the games. These included Emily Bresnehan, Nicholas Georgiou, Joshua Cooley, Olivia Lefoe, Jack Williams, Makar Kiselnikov, Ben Putamorsi, Hayden Ross. Nicholas Georgiou snapped up a medal in the 16yrs 400m Freestyle Relay. Well done to everyone who qualified and participated.

2016 VICTORIAN LONG COURSE AGE CHAMPS

The 2016 Victorian Age Championships were held on 12th to 17th December and on a per capita basis Bayside performed extremely well coming in 7th place in Victoria when removing visiting clubs with a combined point score of 530. Bayside swimmers overall achieved a 69% PB ratio (139/200) with a great Male PB performance of 73% (88/139) and a great Female PB performance of 62.0% (51/139) which are great achievements. As you will see below there were a large amount of Bayside Club Long Course records broken by the below swimmers. A fantastic achievement by all of our swimmers.

There are a number of our swimmers who made National qualifying times during the Victorian Age Championships and others that are painstakingly close. Well done to those that have made Nationals already - congratulations!

Our swimmers also won an incredible 15 medals at the championships. UNREAL!!! Here is the Bayside medal tally: 7 GOLD, 3 SILVER, 5 BRONZE . Well done to all medal winners! This is the highest number of medals I can ever remember! :-) AND....the Medal winners were:

Emily Bresnehan: SILVER in the Girls 14 Year Olds 100 LC Meter Backstroke with an amazing time of 1:06.78 (over 1 sec PB) to break her own Bayside record that she set at Nationals this year. Emily also came 8th in Victoria in the Girls 14 Year Olds 200 LC Meter Backstroke. Emily was also a member of the Girls 14 & Under 200 LC Meter Medley Relay that came 9th in Victoria with a time of 2:09.30. Well done!!!



Nicholas Georgiou: GOLD in the Boys 16 Year Olds 100m Freestyle with a fantastic swim from Lane 1 of 53.22. Nick took the lead early and basically smashed the spirit of other swimmers to win. What a swim! Nick also snatched the Bayside record held for the last 5 years by 1.3 seconds. Great swim! Nick also went on to grab GOLD for the Boys 16 Year Olds 50m Freestyle recording a time of 24.20 to beat the previous record (also held for 5 years) by 0.44 seconds. Nick swam well in the Boys 16 Year Olds 200IM to win a BRONZE medal with a Bayside record breaking time of 2:10.22. Nick beat the previously held record by more than 6 seconds! Phenomenal! Sensational meet Nick - well done

Arthur Kiselnikov: BRONZE in the Boys 15 Year Olds 50 LC Meter Freestyle with a time of 24.80 breaking the Bayside record by 0.01 seconds from James Nettlefold who set the record 5 years ago. Phew! Great effort Arthur. Arthur also came 8th in Victoria in the Boys 15 Year Olds 100 LC Meter Freestyle, 6th Victorian in the Boys 15 Year Olds 100 LC Meter Breaststroke with a great time of 1:09.80, 6th in Victoria in the Boys 15 Year Olds 200 LC Meter Freestyle, 8th in Victoria in the Boys 15 Year Olds 200 LC Meter IM and 4th in Victoria in the Boys 15 Year Olds 100 LC Meter Butterfly with a sub 1:00 minute time! What a great achievement, well done!



Olivia Lefoe: 3 GOLD medals in the Girls 12 Year Olds 100 LC Meter Freestyle, Girls 12 Year Olds 200 LC Meter Freestyle and Girls 12 Year Olds 50 LC Meter Freestyle with times of 1:02.65, 28.21 and 2:14.52 respectively. Olivia also broke the previous Bayside records set for the 50m Freestyle and 200m Freestyle. Olivia also won a SILVER medal for the Girls 12 Year Olds 100 LC Meter Butterfly swimming a Bayside record time of 1:08.55, a BRONZE medal for the Girls 12 Year Olds 200 LC Meter IM swimming a Bayside record time of 2:38.58 and a BRONZE medal in the Girls 13 & Under 400 LC Meter Freestyle swimming another Bayside record time of 4:42.43. Congratulations and well done!!

Hannah Schmidt: 2 GOLD medals in the Girls 13 Year Olds 100 LC Meter Freestyle with an amazing time of 1:00.20 breaking her own Bayside record and the Girls 13 Year Olds 50 LC Meter Freestyle with a Bayside record time of 28.33. This is the 3rd month in a row where Hannah has beaten her previous Bayside record for the 100m LC Freestyle! BRONZE in the Girls 13 Year Olds 200 LC Meter Freestyle with a Bayside record time of 2:12.89 surpassing her previous record time. Hannah also came 6th in the Girls 13 & Under 400 LC Meter Freestyle with an over 6 second PB time of 4:46.03 to pass the previous two Bayside records Hannah already held! Well done Hannah, a great meet!



Teah Vassiliadis: SILVER medal in the Girls 12 Year Olds 200 LC Meter Butterfly swimming a near 2 second PB and also setting a new Bayside record - beating her own previous record set a month earlier. Teah was also the 6th in Victoria in the Girls 12 Year Olds 200 LC Meter Freestyle, 4th in the Girls 12 Year Olds 100 LC Meter Butterfly with a 4 second PB over the day and 6th in Victoria in the Girls 12 Year Olds 200 LC Meter Backstroke. Well done Teah, a great meet.
